At Early Explorers, we provide individualized 1-to-1 Early Start Intervention Services in the natural setting of your home for children ages 0-3 to fill the gaps in your child's development using play-based therapy to teach skills and achieve Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) goals. We partner with your family, service coordinators, and other professionals to help your child reach their goals in all aspects of their development.

Our teachers work with your child in their natural environment to teach strategies to build foundational skills such as communicating their wants and needs, playing appropriately with toys, following simple instructions, and interacting during play. Our teachers also make sure to incorporate the child's family members to teach them the strategies to be able to use outside of the Early Intervention Services.

PLAY-BASED THERAPY

Early Explorers provides in-home services designed to engage children in play-based treatment that builds the missing skills needed to meet critical milestones in their development. Our play-based therapy helps stimulate infant and toddler development in the key years when their brains develop the most.

PARENT TRAINING

Parent Training is a key component of our program as it helps teach parents different strategies to interact with their child to help them progress in their development and incorporate these skills in their daily lives. We want to ensure parents and family members feel empowered to help their child bridge the gaps in their development by teaching them techniques on how to interpret behavior and teach their child age-appropriate skills.

STEP 1

LET THE ADVENTURE BEGIN!

Once your child has received their Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP), your Regional Center Service Coordinator will send your referral to our Family Liaison. Our Family Liaison will reach out to schedule a meeting with your new Program Supervisor to review our Intake Paperwork and your child's IFSP goals.

STEP 2

GRAB YOUR MAP & COMPASS

Once your paperwork is completed and submitted, our Early Explorers Care Coordinator will review your availability and will reach out to confirm a good start date. We will match your child with a teacher at their first session.

STEP 3

MEET YOUR ADVENTURE GUIDE

During your first session, your teacher and Program Supervisor will play and interact with your child to assess their skill levels and what types of activities your child enjoys. The goal is to get to know your child and develop what strategies will work best for them to help them learn and reach their highest potential.

STEP 4

EMBARK ON YOUR JOURNEY
